The Village of South Zanesville intends to contract for new engineering, surveying, and construction services in connection with the following new projects: sidewalk, street, and water improvements. Engineering firms interested in being considered for a contract should provide the required services and should reply with a statement of qualification no later than September 27th, 2025, by 4:00pm. Statements received after this deadline will not be considered.

Statements of qualifications should include information regarding the firm's history; education and experience of owners and key technical personnel; the technical expertise of the firm's current staff; the firm's experience in designing similar projects within the last five years; availability of staff; the firm's equipment and facilities; references; the firm's proximity to the Village; any experience and work history with the Village of South Zanesville, however not required, and ODOT pre-qualified. The firm selected will work with OMEGA, who will be overseeing the financing for the projects. The funding obtained will be through various sources, such as, CDBG-NRG, ODOT Tap, ODOT Safe Routes., ODNR and OPWC.

The project includes the acquisition of, and preparation of preliminary and final design, construction plans and specifications, and bidding and construction phase engineering services including Resident Project Representative for the referenced project. Statements of qualification shall be transmitted to: Mayor Barb Lloyd, Village of South Zanesville, 24 East Main Street, South Zanesville, OH 43701. As required by Ohio Rev. Code 153.65-71, responding firms will be evaluated and ranked in order of their qualifications. Following this evaluation, the Village of South Zanesville will enter contract negotiations with the most highly qualified firm for two years (2025-2027), with the possibility of extending it another two years and thereafter.
